To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Edgar B. Page of Ada County, Idaho Territory

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office of Boise City, Idaho Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Edgar B. Page

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, including that of March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1877, for the lots numbered three and four, the south half of the north east quarter, the north west quarter and the south half of section eight in township three north of range two east of Boise Meridian in Idaho Territory, containing six hundred and eighteen acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Edgar B. Page

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edgar B. Page

and to his heirs, the said Tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Edgar B. Page

and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
